



SCHOOL POLICIES

Academy Profile

The curriculum at THE MAKEUP ACADEMY NYC was designed for both aspiring makeup artists and beauty lovers alike, and was inspired by our founder's vision to create beauty in the world around us. Our team of makeup professionals aim to provide guidance to the creative talent of our students, through intensive hands-on training and individualized feedback.

Enrollment Policy

Candidates must be over 18 years of age (unless given signed permission by a parent/guardian) and hold a high school diploma or equivalent. The individual must have a basic understanding of the English language and have valid photo ID. Copies of both must be provided prior to enrollment.

In addition to the above, advanced programs require students to participate in an admissions interview with an instructor prior to being accepted to the program. A \$100 non

refundable, registration fee will be required upon each application submission. After acceptance onto the program through the approval of our Enrollment Agreement, students will be required to pay a deposit to secure a spot within the program. The remainder of the tuition is to be paid in weekly installments.

The student will be provided with materials pertaining to the program. If the student withDraws during the program, the student will be held liable for the cost of any materials received as part of the program. Refunds will be issued based upon the school's refund policy.

Additional Costs:

For some programs, students will be provided with a list of products in need of purchasing in addition to that provided in their complimentary makeup kit. The total cost for these materials may vary from \$100 - \$150 depending on where the student decides to make the purchase.

Credit Transfer:

Credits from other institutions cannot be transferred or used in place of the programs offered at THE MAKEUP ACADEMY NYC.

Attendance Policy

Graduation will be contingent upon the attendance requirements of 90% of program hours. Attendance will be monitored throughout the classes by school's teachers through the use of a daily attendance roster. In the event that a substitute is used, the substitute will keep track of the day's attendance. Students who arrive after the first 10 minutes will be allowed to attend the class with the deduction of the training hours when calculating the required hours for completion of the program.

In case of tardiness or absence, the student will be contacted by phone and the results will be recorded.

WithDrawal

If absent three times consecutively without notifying the school, the student will be considered to have dropped out of the program and will be contacted by phone and in writing of this status. Results will be recorded on the Absent/Drop Form. The student will also be informed that the tuition paid will remain valid, unless there has been a significant financial or educational change to the program, in which case, extra tuition may be charged. The school will then request that the student respond in writing and provide reasons for withDrawal. The results will be recorded in the Absent/Drop Record Form.

The failure of the student to notify the Academy Director in writing of withDrawal may delay refund of tuition due pursuant to Section 5002 of the Education Law.

Student Code of Conduct

The students are required to maintain their stations in a proper manner by cleaning their workspace, equipment and mirrors after class.

Dress code is limited to that generally considered accepted as appropriate within a classroom, though teachers suggest an all black attire for a more

professional atmosphere. Cellphone usage, eating in class and other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. THE MAKEUP ACADEMY NYC reserves the right to issue a written warning at our discretion to students who do maintain proper decorum in the classroom by being disruptive, as well as to those who do not conduct themselves in a professional manner or lack respect for their fellow students. Dismissed students will be refunded their tuition as outlined in the Refund Policy.

Students must return all THE MAKEUP ACADEMY NYC Studio materials and makeup at the end of each class prior to departure.

Consuming, selling or possession of drugs or alcohol in the premises is completely illegal and will result in immediate termination of the student's contract.

NYC THE MAKFUP **ACADEMY** workshops are hands-on and interactive in nature. All students will be given the opportunity to model as well practice techniques taught throughout the program. Models are expected to actively participate and be mindful of the others students' needs. In turn, students are required to be respectful, professional, well mannered and uphold the Student Code of Conduct at all times.

Graduation Requirements

MAKFUP **ACADEMY** THE NYC requires students to complete the course requirements and maintain minimum attendance.

The student will be assessed every week during the course of the program. Any student who has not maintained satisfactory academic progress shall be dismissed or placed on academic probation. Satisfactory academic progress consists of 75% passing grade on all assignments, including that assigned as independent work by the instructors.

Successful completion of the program requires an in-class attendance rate of at least 90% of the total hours of the program. The issuance of a certificate upon completion of the program requires that students attend the above-mentioned minimum in-class hours, which includes classes taken to make up for those during which they were absent.

Leave of Absence

No leave of absence will be granted due to the short duration of our programs.

Student Complaints

A student may file a complaint verbally or in writing form at any time to any instructor or administrator. Upon receipt of the complaint, it shall be transmitted as soon as possible to the Academy Director. The student may also directly lodge a complaint with the Academy Director. The person notified and/or the Academy Director will attempt to resolve the complaint. in a timely matter.

The steps to file a complaint with the New York State Education Department are as followed:

1. Write to the New York State Education Department at 116 West 32nd Street, 5th Floor, New York, NY 10001, or telephone at (212) 643-4760, requesting an interview for the purpose of filing a written complaint. Bring all relevant documents with you to the interview, including an enrollment agreement, financial aid application, transcripts, etc. An investigator will meet you and go through your complaint in detail.

If you cannot come for an interview, send a letter or call the office to request a complaint form. Please include with it copies of all relevant documents. You should keep the originals. You must file a complaint within two years after the alleged illegal conduct took place. The Bureau cannot investigate any complaint made more than two years after the date of occurrence.

The investigator will attempt to resolve the complaint as quickly as

possible and may contact you in the future with follow-up questions. You should provide all information requested as quickly as possible; delay may affect the investigation of your complaint. When appropriate, the investigator will try to negotiate with the school informally. If the Department determines that violations of the law have been committed and the school fails to take satisfactory and appropriate action then the Department may proceed with formal disciplinary charaes.

Please refer to the Business Disclosure Pamphlet from the school's admission agent for additional information.

Disclosure Statement

The student should be aware that information in the catalog may be subject to change. It is recommended that students considering enrollment check with the director to determine if there is any change from the information provided in the catalog.

Please be advised that the New York State Education Department separately licenses all teaching personnel and independently approves all courses and curricula offered.

Therefore, it is possible that courses/ curricula listed in the school's catalog may not be approved at the time that a student enrolls in the school or the teaching personnel listed in the catalog may have changed.

It is again recommended that the

student check with the Academy Director to determine if there are any changes in the courses/curricula offered or the teaching personnel listed in the catalog.

Schools are required to give this disclosure pamphlet to individuals interested in enrolling in their school.

What You Should Know about Licensed Private Schools and Registered Business Schools in New York State. What is the purpose of this pamphlet?

All prospective and enrolled students in a non-degree granting proprietary school are required to receive this pamphlet. This pamphlet provides an overview of students' rights with regard to filing a complaint against a school and accessing the tuition reimbursement fund if they are a victim of certain violations by the school.

Licensed private career schools which are licensed by the New York State Education Department are required to meet very specific standards under the Education Law and Commissioner's Regulations. These standards are designed to help insure the educational appropriateness of the programs which schools offer. It is important for you to realize that the New York State Education Department's Bureau of Proprietary School Supervision closely monitors and regulates all non-degree granting proprietary schools. The schools are required to have their teachers meet standards in order to be licensed by the Department. Schools are also required to have their curriculum approved by the New York State Education Department, at minimum, every four years, thereby helping to insure that all curriculum offered in the schools are educationally sound.

In addition, staff members of the Bureau of Proprietary School Supervision are often in the school buildings monitoring the educational programs being offered. The interest of the New York State Education Department is to ensure that the educational program being offered meets your needs and that your financial investment is protected.

The New York State Education Department's Bureau of Proprietary School Supervision wishes you success in your continued efforts to obtain the necessary skill training in order to secure meaningful employment. In addition, Bureau staff will continue to work with all the schools to help insure that a quality educational program is provided to you.

Who can file a complaint?

If you are or were a student or an employee of a Licensed Private Career School in the State of New York and you believe that the school or anyone representing the school has acted unlawfully, you have the right to file a complaint with the New York State Education Department.

What can a student or employee

complain about?

You may make complaints about the conduct of the school, advertising, standards and methods of instruction, equipment, facilities, qualifications of teaching and management personnel, enrollment agreement, methods of collecting tuition and other charges, school license or registration, school and student records, and private school agents.

How can a complaint be filed by a student or employee?

You should try to resolve your complaint directly with the school unless you believe that the school would penalize you for your complaint. Use the school's internal grievance procedure or discuss your problems with teachers, department heads, or the school director. We suggest that you do so in writing and that you keep copies of all correspondence to the school. However, the school cannot require you to do this before you file a complaint with the New York State Education Department. If you do file a complaint with the Department, please advise the Bureau of any action that you have taken to attempt to resolve your complaint.

The steps you must take to file a complaint with the New York State Education Department are:

1. Write to the New York State Education Department at 116 West 32nd Street, 5th Floor, New York, New York 10001, or telephone the Department at (212) 643-4760, requesting an interview for the purpose of filing a written complaint. Bring all relevant documents with you to the interview, including an enrollment agreement, financial aid application, transcripts, etc. An investigator from the Department will meet with you and go through your complaint in detail.

- 2. If you cannot come for an interview, send a letter or call the office to request a complaint form. You must complete and sign this form and mail it to the office. Please include with it copies of all relevant documents. You should keep the originals. You must file a complaint within two years after the alleged illegal conduct took place. The Bureau cannot investigate any complaint made more than two years after the date of the occurrence.
- 3. The investigator will attempt to resolve the complaint as quickly as possible and may contact you in the future with follow-up questions. You should provide all information requested as quickly as possible; delay may affect the investigation of your complaint. When appropriate, the investigator will try to negotiate with the school informally. If the Department determines that violations of law have been committed and the school fails to take satisfactory and appropriate action then the Department may proceed with formal disciplinary charges.

What is the Tuition Reimbursement Fund?

The Tuition Reimbursement Fund is designed to protect the financial interest of students attending non-degree proprietary schools. If a school closes while you are in attendance, prior to the completion of your educational program, then you may be eligible for a refund of all tuition expenses which you have paid. If you drop out of school prior to completion and you file a complaint against the school with the State Education Department, you may be eligible to receive a tuition refund if the State Education Department is able to provide factual support that your complaint is valid and to determine that there was a violation of Education Law or the Commissioner's Regulations as specified in Section 126.17 of the Commissioner's Regulations. To file a claim to the Tuition Reimbursement Fund, you must first file a complaint with the State Education Department at the address included in this pamphlet. The staff of the State Education Department will assist you in the preparation of a tuition reimbursement form (a sample of this form should have been provided to you upon enrollment).

What is the tuition refund and cancellation policy?

All schools must have a tuition refund and cancellation policy for each program included in the catalog and in the student enrollment agreement.

Read and understand the school's policy regarding tuition refund and

cancellation before you sign the enrollment agreement. If you do not understand it, or are confused by the school's explanation, get help before you sign. You may ask for assistance from the Department at the address included in this pamphlet.

What should students know about "private school agents?"

Private School Agents are employed by schools for the purpose of recruiting or enrolling students in the school; they are not school counselors. Private school agents cannot require a student to pay a placement or referral fee. Each school agent must be licensed by the New York State Education Department, must have an Agent identification card and must be a salaried employee of the school. School agents who cannot show an Agent Identification Card are breaking the law if they try to interest students in enrolling in a particular school or group of schools. The name(s) of the agent(s) who enrolled a student must appear on that student's enrollment agreement. Therefore, you should write down the name of the agent, who spoke with you. Each student will be required to confirm the name(s) of the agent(s) when signing the enrollment agreement. A full refund shall be made to any student recruited by an unlicensed private school agent or even by a licensed agent if there is evidence that the agent made fraudulent or improper claims. To find out if you are eligible to receive a refund, you must follow the complaint procedures included in this page.

What should students know about grants and guaranteed student" loans"?

A grant is awarded to a student based on income eligibility, and it does not need to be repaid (for example, New York State Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) grants or Pell grants provided by the federal aovernment).

Guaranteed student loans are low interest loans provided under the Federal Guaranteed Student Loan Program. The decision to apply for such a loan is yours - the school cannot require that you apply for a loan. You should understand that if vou pay school tuition with money loaned to you from a lender you are responsible for repaying the loan in full, with interest, in accordance with the terms of the loan agreement.

A failure to repay the loan can hurt your credit rating and result in legal action against you. Even if you fail to complete your educational program, you are still responsible for repaying all of the money loaned to you. It is your right to select a lender for a guaranteed student loan. The school cannot require you to apply to a particular lender or lending institution. However, the school can recommend a lender, but if it does, the school must also provide you with a statement about your right and ability to obtain a loan from another lender and the insurance premiums charged on these loans.

Read and understand all the information and applications for financial aid arants and loans before signing.
